

Sindarin Flash Cards

General Instructions

You really need heavy opaque paper for this.

1. Print the fronts of the cards.
2. Reverse the page order by either configuring your printer to print in the reverse order or simply stack the pages you just printed so they are in the reverse order.
3. To find out how you should load the tray, draw an arrow on a blank piece of paper and insert it on top in the printer tray.
4. Print **just one page** of text. If the printing is on top of the arrow or if the arrow points to the bottom of the page, you need to load the paper in another direction. Keep trying until you get the arrow on the back of the page you print, but pointing up. Remember this way of loading the tray.
5. Load the pages you printed in step 1 into the paper tray in the same direction you found in step 4.
6. Print the pages (in reverse order, so the backs match up with the fronts).
7. Cut out the individual cards with a paper trimmer or pair of scissors.

There are a few awkward page breaks. Sometimes just 2 cards will print on one page. When I set this up for my own study, I did not much worry about a wasted piece of paper or two, as long as the fronts and backs matched up. There will be people out there who are much better at Microsoft Word than I am (just about anyone, I should think), and can get rid of the annoying breaks in the table. If you like, save it to your own computer and play with it there.
